Dr Viviana Narotzky is a design historian, writer, artist and curator. She lectures internationally on design, city life and material culture, and curates events and exhibitions on contemporary and 20C design. She was the founder and Director of the International Open Design / Shared Creativity conference, and of the DEMO festival of experimental and crossover design, both part of the Barcelona Design Festival.

Dr Narotzky has been Senior Research Fellow and Acting Director at the Centre for the Study of the Domestic Interior based at the Royal College of Art and the Victoria & Albert Museum, London; Tutor on the RCA/V&A History of Design MA; and Director of the History of Design MA at Kingston University. She has been President of ADI-FAD, the Industrial Designer's Association based at the Barcelona Design Museum.

Viviana Narotzky regularly consults on art and design related projects. She has worked with institutions such as the World Economic Forum, the Victoria & Albert Museum, the European Union Intellectual Property Office, Hong Kong Television and the Barcelona Design Hub. She is a Board Member of ICHDS, International Committee of Design History and Studies and of the International Armenia Art Fair.
